Two Parkland High School graduating seniors who will be attending an institution of higher learning will each receive a \$500 scholarship.

Requirements:

- 1.) Student must have attended Schnecksville Elementary School for at least one full academic year with one of the year's being 5th grade.
- 2.) Student will be a graduating senior from PHS in June of the school year in which the application is being submitted.
- 3.) Student will be attending an institution of higher education within 6 months of High School Graduation. A letter of confirmation from the HS Guidance Office or the institution to be attending shall be provided with the application.
- 4.) Student must complete application above.
- 5.) Two letters of recommendation must be submitted, with one reference being from a Parkland School District faculty member.
- 6.) The following essay question shall be answered and submitted with the application:
"Which Schnecksville Elementary School staff member had the greatest influence on you, how did he/she influence you, and how will, or have you, used this influence?"
- 7.) The essay must be typed and be no more than 600 words.
- 8.) Applications and essays are due to the PHS Guidance Office by March 23rd, 2012. The Scholarship winners will be determined by the Schnecksville Elementary PTO Scholarship Committee and they will be notified by mail in May 2012.
